These figures are derived from the "2015 Poverty Guidelines for the 48 Contiguous States and the District of Columbia" as published in the Federal Register of January 22, 2015 on pages 3236-3237. The annual income levels provided above are derived by multiplying the federal poverty guidelines annual income for each family size by 2 (200%) and rounding to the nearest whole dollar. These annual figures are then divided by 12 and rounded to the nearest whole dollar to derive the monthly income levels.
